By Clive Cussler

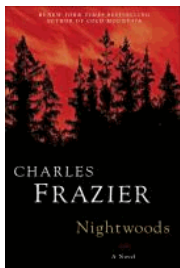

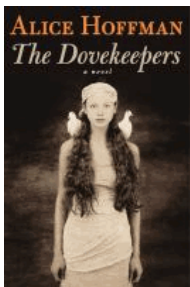
English major Madeleine Hanna must choose between two suitors while working on her senior thesis on the marriage plot that lies at the heart of the greatest English novels.

By Alice Hoffman

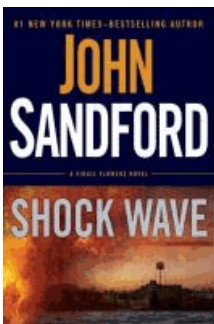

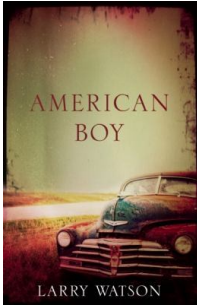

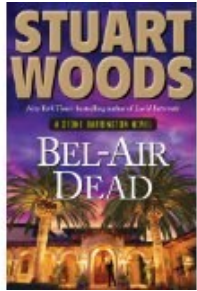
